Our Vision is to continue the mission of the Palmdale Promise and ensure all of our students are reaching their full potential by:



 - College counselor, Advisor, intervention classes,; tutoring






Programs: Next Year

- Supports and interventions




Advancement Via Individual Determination

- Provide professional development that supports our AVID program





- Professional development and IB training for our staff




Career Technical Pathways
