Dual Immersion Schools

Palmdale School District provides high quality Dual Immersion Programs. Los Amigos and Dos Caminos are both recipients of the prestigious CAFE Seal of Excellence Award. The CAFE Seal of Excellence Award is one of the highest awards the organization has to recognize schools for their vision of biliteracy, their commitment towards educational excellence for all students, and their focus on providing students with the skills they will need to be successful in the 21st Century. Both programs also have the honor of being home to multiple CAFE Teacher of the Year recipients, Para educator and Parent of the Year recognitions. The 50/50 English/Spanish model continues to be successful and in-demand. In response, Palmdale School District has added Dual Immersion Plazas at Tamarisk, Manzanita, Tumbleweed, and Desert Rose Elementary Schools.
