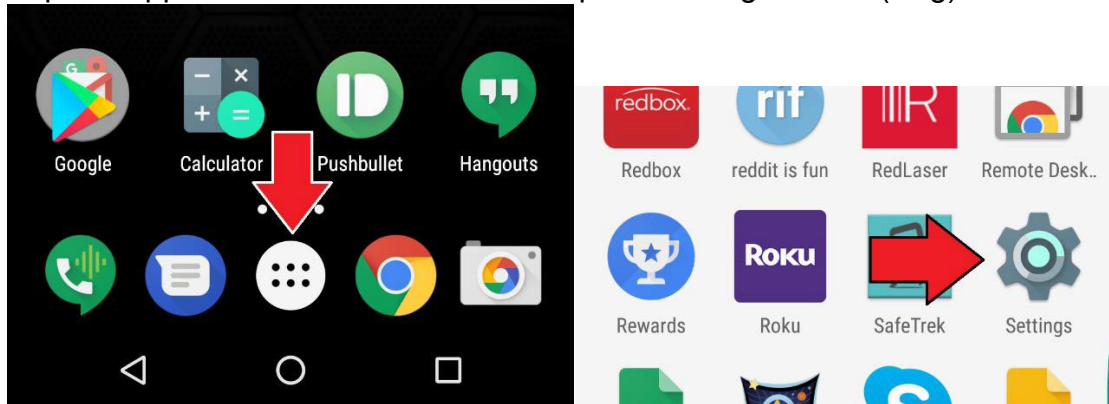


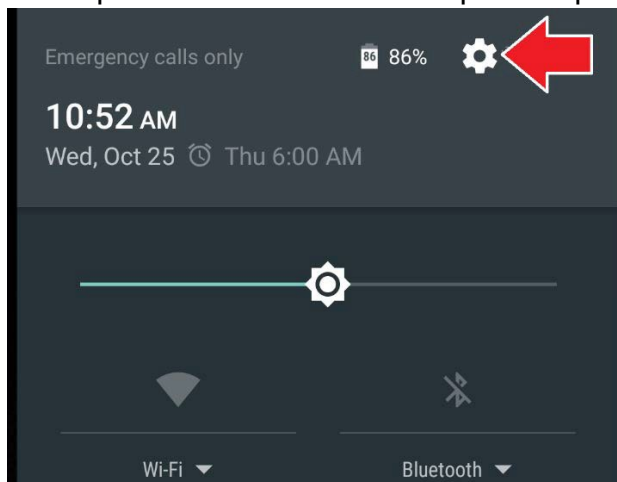
How to Connect your Android device to the Palmdale School District Wireless Network

Please note that the following directions are based on the Google version of Android. Each manufacturer adjusts Android for their own needs, so there may be some variance in how to connect.

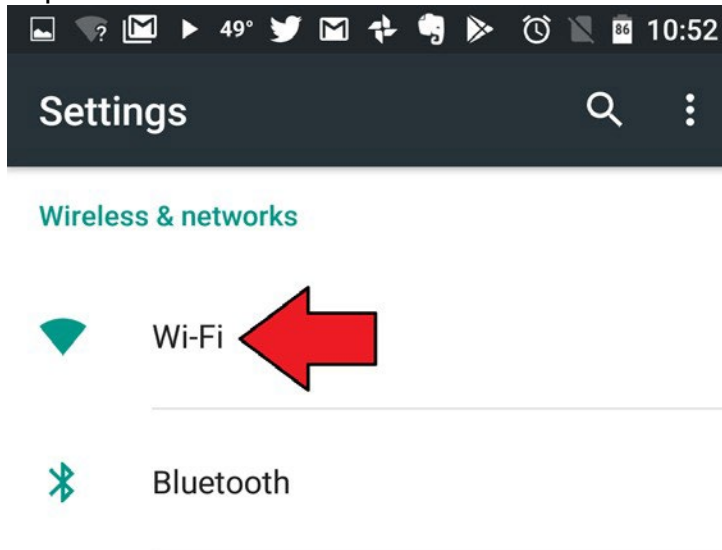
1. Tap the Applications menu button and tap the Settings button (Cog)



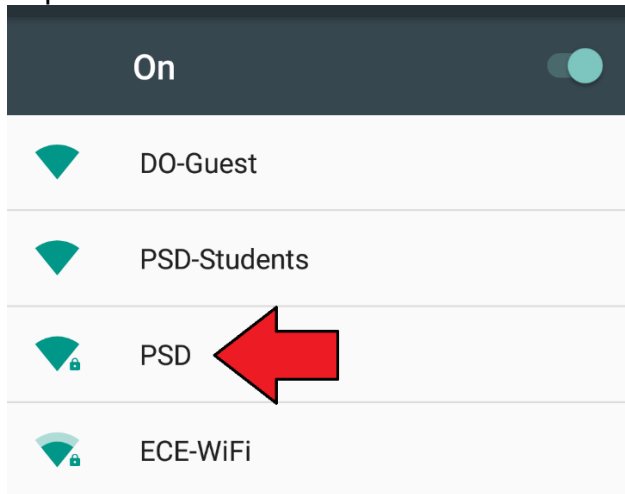
Or swipe down twice from the top and tap the Settings button (Cog)



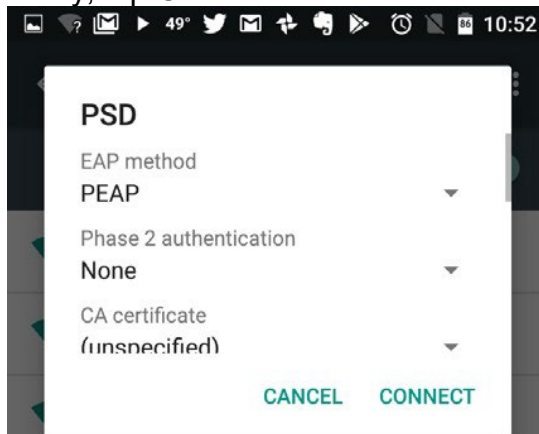
2. Tap Wi-Fi



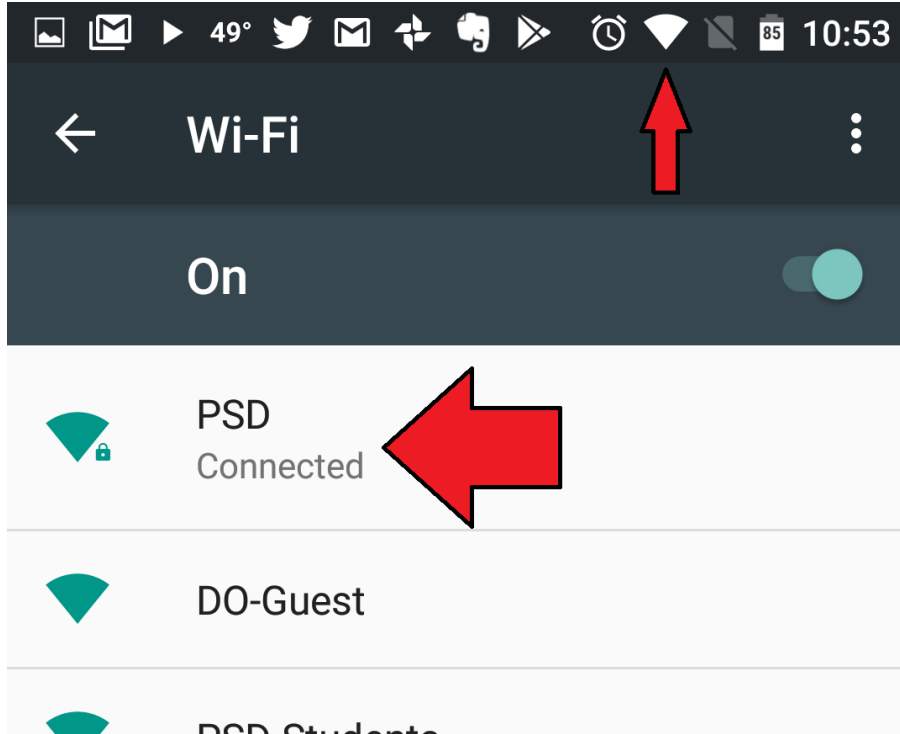
3. Tap PSD



4. Scroll down and fill out the Identity and Password fields with your Active Directory credentials (the same login you use for IC, a Windows computer, and the district website). Set the EAP Method to EAP-TTLS, set the EAP Phase 2 Authentication to MSCHAPv2, uncheck the Server CA Certificate option, and finally, tap Connect



- Once you have joined, you will see a radio signal in the upper portion of the screen, and PSD will have "Connected" underneath it in the Wi-Fi network list. Typically, it will connect again each time it is in range of the district wireless, without you having to log in again, regardless of the school site. It also works at the District Office and in the SDA.



6. If you should have issues connecting to the wireless when you were connected before, and you know that you are in the range of the PSD wireless, then go into Setting > Wi-Fi and tap PSD and then tap Forget. You will have to log in again, but it solves many connection issues.

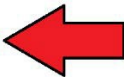
